NEOYBL CODE OF CONDUCT for:

Parents & Players

NEOYBL provides a safe and balanced learning environment for players of all abilities that develops athletic skills, character, sportsmanship, and teamwork for school children grades 1st through 6th through their participation. NEOYBL wants to promote the physical, social and emotional development of youth participants. It is therefore essential for parents, coaches and officials to encourage youth athletes to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Moreover, adults involved in youth sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect and self-control. As a parent or guardian of a NEOYBL player, I therefore pledge to be responsible for my (and any other parent, guardian or guest of my child) words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating or participating in a youth sports event and shall conform my behavior to the following code of conduct:

1. I (and my guests) will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for the youth participants, not adults.

2. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.

3. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; verbal or physical threats; or using profane language or gestures.

4. I (and my guests) will not engage, or encourage my child or any other person to engage, in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or wellbeing of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.

5. I (and my guests) will treat, and insure my child treats, any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, age, sex, creed, or ability.

6. I (and my guests) will not initiate, and will not tolerate my child initiating a verbal or physical fight, abuse, negative comments or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.

7. I (and my guests) will not embarrass my child or officials by calling attention to him/her through loud, demeaning or rude behavior.

8. I (and my guests) will encourage my child to practice good sportsmanship.

9. I (and my guests) will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition. Also, never call out any player by name or number and yell demeaning comments about child's ability or physical features.

10. I (and my guests) will promote the emotional and physical well-being of all the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.

11. I agree to have my child participate in regular practices and games, failure to do so will result in limit or no playing time. (Depending on how many missed practices/games) Tournaments do not require a coach to play all players.

12. I (and my guests) will not post any negative comments or posts on social media regarding NEOYBL players, officials, parents, volunteers, or coaches.

13. I (and my guests) will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never confront officials/coaches at the game. I will communicate my concerns to one of the NEOYBL Board of Directors or representatives of that location.

I hereby agree that if I (or other parent, guardian, or guests of my child) fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, or participating in a NEOYBL event I and/or my child will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

- 1. Verbal warning issued by NEOYBL board member or representative of any league town who is authorized to issue such warning.
- 2. Second warning is suspension or immediate ejection from a NEOYBL event.
- Final warning is suspension for the remainder of that basketball season. <u>These warnings can be issued in any order depending how severity of violation.</u>
